

Translation Milestones

- Suryoyo— Praise God for completion of the New Testament. Pray as work on the Old Testament continues.
- Assyrian—Praise that the New Testament is now completed and on its way
 to the printer in Korea. Pray that
 printing will go smoothly and for the
 translators now free to concentrate fully
 on Old Testament translation.
- Ma'luli—Praise for safety for the translators in the Eastern Mediterranean.
 Pray as final checking of the New Testament is completed in preparation for layout. Pray also as the translators increasingly are focusing on Old Testament translation.
- Mardini—Praise that the translator's move to the Netherlands has been a good move for him as well as for the project. Pray as he works on Old Testament translation.
- Chaldean—Praise that the checking of 1
 Samuel is nearing the end. Pray that checking of Ezra, Nehemiah and Esther as well as 2 Samuel will go smoothly.
- Old Testament Publication We want to release Old Testament books in each language as they are completed. Pray for our translators and project advisors as they prepare already drafted books for publishing while continuing new translation simultaneously.

Jesus Loves me... the Bible Tells Me So!

March 21st was a special day in the history of the Suryoyo speaking world - the formal dedication and celebration of the publishing of the New Testament in Suryoyo. It was printed by the American and Korean Bible Societies with support from the Turkish Bible Society. Fifteen years in the making, it represents the life work of Dr. Abdul-Massih Saadi who
